WHEN AND WHERE CAN I REGISTER?

Registration for the 2018 Summit opens officially August 15th and can be accessed via The Vision Council web site at <https://www.thevisioncouncil.org/executivesummit>.

DOES THE VISION COUNCIL PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE AIRPORT/RESORT?

Valet Parking is \$49 per night for overnight guests.

Rideshare options such as Uber and Lyft are also available. Pickup and drop off locations are located at both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.

- Terminal 1: Exit baggage claim via the escalators, walk across the Sky Bridge toward Ground Transportation and the parking lot, exit down the escalators toward the parking lot, and the location is at the foot of the escalators along the sidewalk.
- Terminal 2: Upon exiting baggage claim, proceed toward the Elevated Departure Roadway. The location is between American and Delta/United check-in. Look for the red umbrella.
