Here are some details about the Executive Summit and The Ritz-Carlton, Naples

Getting to the Summit: The closest commercial airport is Ft. Myers' **Southwest Florida International Airport** (RSW), located 30 miles from the resort. Transportation via rideshare providers such as Uber and Lyft, rental car, car service, and taxi is available from the airport. Allow 35–45 minutes travel time from the airport to the hotel.

Please note: There are two The Ritz-Carlton resorts in Naples. The Executive Summit will be hosted at the oceanfront resort, The Ritz-Carlton, Naples, located at 280 Vanderbilt Beach Road, Naples, Florida, 34108.

Weather: While we hope for fabulous weather for our outdoor events, it is January and can be cool in the evenings. The typical daytime high hovers around the mid-70s°F (around 20°C), while the nighttime low settles in the upper-50s°F to low-60s°F (approximately 15°C). We will have outdoor events in the evenings, so please plan accordingly.

Dress: Resort casual (no formal cocktail or black-tie events)

Monday Evening Welcome Reception – interactive dining on the beach at sunset Tuesday Dinner – upscale interactive dining outdoors in the courtyard Tuesday After Party – extend the networking with drinks & desserts (outdoor)
