



WELCOME TO THE 2026 EXECUTIVE SUMMIT

Here are some details about the Executive Summit and The Ritz-Carlton Amelia Island, Florida

Getting to the Summit: The closest airport is Jacksonville International Airport (JAX), located approximately 30 miles from the resort. Allow at least 35 minutes travel time to and from the airport.

Transportation in Amelia Island: Transportation (via rideshare providers such as Uber and Lyft, rental car, car service, and taxi) is available from the airport, but may be limited or delayed without notice, so we encourage you to book these services in advance.

Consider downloading and using the WRYD (ride) transportation app, which locals commonly use. Wyrd makes getting a ride easier in less-populated areas. We've all been to the larger metroplexes and can easily hail a ride using a ride-sharing app. Unlike those apps, Wyrd only uses local transportation companies that you're already using, and updates them with mobile options you're used to.

Upon the conclusion of the Executive Summit, guests will manage their own transportation. As with arrivals, we encourage you to book these services in advance.

Weather: While we hope for fabulous weather for our outdoor events, it is January and temperatures can be cool. The anticipated daytime high hovers around the mid-60s°F (around 20°C), while the nighttime low settles in the low 40s°F (approximately 5°C).

We will have outdoor events in the evenings, so please plan accordingly.

Dress: Resort casual (no formal cocktail or black-tie events). Please wear comfortable shoes.
